Day 1 - Departure - Depart USA

Day 2 - Munich - Arrive in Munich and transfer to your hotel. Take time to rest after the journey, then enjoy dinner with the group. Overnight stay in Munich marks the beginning of your trip.

Day 3 - Munich - Enjoy a morning tour of Munich's highlights, including Marienplatz, Maximilianstrasse, the Olympic Village, BMW building, and St. Peter's Church. In the afternoon, visit Dachau Concentration Camp Memorial. Dinner and overnight stay in Munich.

Day 4 - Munich - Altötting - Burghausen - Munich - Travel to Altötting to visit the Marian Shrine and Church of St. Konrad. Stop at Burghausen Castle before returning to Munich for dinner. Overnight stay in Munich concludes a meaningful day.

Day 5 - Munich - Ettal - Oberammergau - Neuschwanstein - Innsbruck - Visit Ettal Monastery with its Baroque basilica, continue to Oberammergau for free time, then stop at Neuschwanstein Castle. Travel to Innsbruck for dinner & overnight stay, surrounded by Tyrolean mountain scenery.

Day 6 - Innsbruck - Vaduz - St. Gallen - Depart Innsbruck, travel through Tyrol, and stop in Vaduz, Liechtenstein's capital. Continue into Switzerland to St. Gallen, known for its historic abbey. Dinner and overnight stay provide time to relax after the journey.

Day 7 - St. Gallen - Einsiedeln - This morning, visit the UNESCO World Heritage Abbey of St. Gallen with its cathedral and library. In the afternoon, continue to Einsiedeln, home to Switzerland's most important pilgrimage site. Dinner and overnight stay.

Day 8 - Einsiedeln - Lucerne - Tour Einsiedeln Monastery, admired for its Baroque architecture and famous Black Madonna. Afterwards, transfer to Lucerne, a charming lakeside city. Enjoy free time before dinner. Overnight stay in Lucerne awaits.



Day 9 - Lucerne - After breakfast, explore Lucerne with a guided tour including Chapel Bridge, medieval walls, and lively squares. The afternoon is free for leisure or optional excursions. Dinner and overnight stay complete the day.

Day 10 - Lucerne - Lake Constance - Stein am Rhein - Zurich - Take a scenic boat ride on Lake Constance, then continue to Stein am Rhein to admire its medieval old town. In the evening, arrive in Zurich for dinner and overnight stay.

Day 11 - Zurich - Bern - Zurich - Excursion to Bern, Switzerland's capital. Guided tour highlights include arcaded streets, the Clock Tower, and Rose Garden. Return to Zurich in the evening for dinner and overnight stay before your final day.

Day 12 - Zurich - Departure - Enjoy breakfast and some free time before transferring to Zurich Airport for your flight home. This marks the conclusion of a memorable journey through Germany, Austria, and Switzerland.
